

Associate in General Studies

The Associate in General Studies (AGS) is for students who wish to study a variety of areas without committing to a specific field and is designed to provide exposure to a wide array of educational experiences. This degree provides a general background for students who wish to transfer but are undecided about a major and for those simply seeking a general educational experience preparing to enter the world of work or for life enrichment.

You must

- fulfill the **Specific Requirements from Group I, II, III, and IV** below;
- fulfill the **General Education Graduation Requirements** listed on pages 7, 8 and 9 of this booklet;
- and complete **electives** (choose from the list beginning on page 23) for the required total of credit hours.

To receive an associate degree, you must complete a total of 62 credit hours, with at least 30 of the last 45 credits from Mott, and with a cumulative grade point average of at least 2.0. Credit hours (cr) and contact hours (ct) are not necessarily the same.

Specific Requirements: A total of 36 credits in Humanities, Natural Sciences & Mathematics, Social Sciences, and Occupational Sciences.
